

FIND PUBLISHED DOCUMENTS

When you publish documents from DAD they are stored in the Documents view.

DAD automatically builds links between all the components and connectors and any document which shows them. This is important as it allows you to assess which documents may need to be re-issued when you edit some feature of a component. This simple link means that DAD automatically performs an exercise that can be so difficult with drawings.

“What (other) drawings are affected by this change?”
